The regular maintenance budget does not cover the periodic major work that is required to maintain the church facilities. Over the years this often expensive and essential work has been made possible by special contributions from both present and past members.

Most of the work on the old Sunday school, and side rooms was complete in November. The installation of cabinetry and the porch is underway and the roof repair scheduled. The badly needed repair to the portico of the WB Smith building is underway. We are prayerfully seeking funding for our WACO 100 radio ministry. Through this ministry, we currently reach many homes in our community through a pre-recorded service at 10:00 a.m. every Sunday. To meet other important ministry needs such as providing assistance for local missions, we have made the decision to remove this ministry from our budget.
